Dear Mr. Costa,

The City of Newport, Department of Utilities, Water Division (NWD) has received a request to extend the water service after the water meter and associated backflow device. Although NWD owns the water meter, the ownership of the service ends at the curb stop. NWD does not object to the extension onto private property, but it is important to note that the flow is limited to a maximum of 35 gallons per minute (gpm). The property owner is responsible for ensuring that the potable water system inside the premises is protected from contamination and properly maintained in compliance with the current plumbing code. Any additions, alterations, or repairs must fully comply with the code and not compromise the safety, sanitation, or integrity of the existing or public water system.

The approval issued here does not replace or exempt this project from any environmental, technical, or regulatory approval requirements outlined in state and federal laws and regulations. These requirements, including those administered by the City of Newport, still apply to this project.
